



VMCC Banbury Run, 7th JUNE 2026

AUTOJUMBLE and TRADE STANDS

Autojumblers and classic vehicle suppliers are invited to book to attend the 76th Banbury Run, which takes place at the British Motor Museum at Gaydon, Warwickshire on Sunday 7th June 2026.

Pitches are laid out on part of the museum's tarmacked car park, and a pitch consists of two normal-size car parking bays. On request these can be two in-line or two side-by-side, depending on how you would prefer your van to fit into your pitch.

One pitch costs £35, which includes a vehicle pass, two admission wristbands and camping for two for Saturday night (in your vehicle, on your pitch). A booking for two pitches includes a vehicle pass, three wristbands and Saturday night camping. A booking for three pitches includes two vehicle passes, four wristbands and Saturday night camping. Arrival is from 12 noon on Saturday 7th June (but overnight campers must arrive by 8pm), set up is from 7am-9am on Sunday 8th June, with departure by 6pm that day. Stallholders can also book and pay to stay in the Gaydon campsite on the Friday, Saturday and/or Sunday nights, and should do so by telephoning the museum on 01926 895295.
