“Cash for your Stash” Autojumble Pitches

Individuals who wish to clear their garages and workshops by selling on unwanted parts, tools and motorcycling accessories can book a “Cash for your Stash” pitch in the Autojumble at The Banbury Run. These pitches are available only to VMCC members who do not regularly sell at autojumbles. The decision of the event organisers will be final on the eligibility of any individual for a “Cash for your Stash” pitch.

The autojumble takes place on part of the museum’s tarmacked car park, and an autojumble pitch consists of two normal-size car parking bays, side by side or in line, at a cost of £35. However, where a VMCC member who is not a regular autojumbler would like to take part but does not have enough to sell to fill a normal pitch, the organisers will pair them up with another member in the same situation so a pitch and its cost is shared. Each booking includes a vehicle pass and an admission wristband for Gaydon, and camping for Saturday night on your pitch.

Arrival is from 12 noon on Saturday 7th June (but overnight campers must arrive by 8pm), set up is from 7am-9am on Sunday 8th June, with departure by 6pm that day. You can also book and pay to stay in the camping area at Gaydon on the Friday, Saturday and/or Sunday nights, and should do so by telephoning the museum on 01926 895295.
